Mark is the Chief Executive of The Children's Society, leading a team of 850 staff and 10,000 volunteers to support vulnerable children across the country. He is deeply committed to addressing the disadvantages faced by many children and young people, with a strong passion for protecting, supporting, and advocating for them.

Originally from County Armagh in Northern Ireland, Mark studied Law at Queen's University in Belfast. After a stint in the private sector, he transitioned to youth work, focusing on uniting Protestant and Catholic young people in a divided town during the lead-up to the Good Friday Agreement.

With over 20 years of experience working with children and young people, including his role as Chief Executive of the social justice charity Church Army, Mark is driven by the belief that every child deserves to thrive, not just survive. He champions a future where every child can walk tall and reach their full potential, free from the constraints of poverty, disadvantage, and fear.

'I want children and young people to know that someone cares, someone listens and someone will help. So they can thrive not just survive.'

<u>The Children's Society</u> is a national charity dedicated to transforming the hopes and happiness of young people facing abuse, exploitation, and neglect. They provide support through the most serious life challenges and campaign tirelessly for significant social changes to improve the lives
