These conferences will bring together secondary school leaders from across Hampshire to collaboratively strengthen practice in:

- High-quality, inclusive teaching.
- Ordinarily Available Provision (OAP).
- Curriculum design, implementation and leadership.
- Strong foundational knowledge.

The conferences will be designed to promote peer-led learning and will be hosted at schools where school leaders showcase and critically reflect on their improvement work.

This aligns with Hampshire's commitment to:

- Improve outcomes for all pupils, particularly those with SEND and subject to economic disadvantage.
- Strengthen inclusive classroom practice.
- Build sustainable, school-led improvement capacity across Hampshire.

The design of the conferences will ensure peer to peer sharing of live school improvement work linking leadership actions to teaching practice and ultimately pupil outcomes.

Each conference will have different foci for the school host led presentations and second keynote:

Activities	Session
Activity 1	Welcome and framing - Local authority priorities and focus on curriculum and teaching and its link to achievement.
Activity 2	School host led presentation - a culture of teaching and learning to maintain high standards, such as: • embedding OAP in classroom practice • curriculum adaptation for SEND • leadership of teaching • quality assurance.
Activity 3	Second keynote - for example: • middle leadership development • whole school reading • making KS3 count.
Activity 4	Workshop/discussion group activities to reflect on learning, consider application to delegates own school context.
