This professional development is designed to empower Deputy Headteachers, Assistant Headteachers and Head of School Leaders to have a sharper impact in their current roles and to prepare leaders for headship.

The aim is to develop aspiring headteachers: giving the leadership skills, depth of knowledge, theory, breadth of understanding and confidence to take on the challenging but exciting role of being a headteacher.

The programme will strengthen the impact of leaders within their current schools and give them the confidence, skills, and knowledge to apply for and successfully secure a headship in the future.

Overview

This **7-session programme** starts in October 2024 and is designed to link to the cycle of school improvement. There will be a series of seminars and visits to schools to see and learn from successful headteachers.

This programme will enable delegates to:

- · explore the place of vision and inspiration in highly effective schools
- be challenged in their view of leadership, developing a greater understanding of transformational and transactional leadership
- develop greater clarity in the need for relentless insistence on refining the quality of teaching and learning
- develop a robust understanding of efficient management of systems and structures
- sharpen their own leadership and empower other leaders to strengthen the quality of the curriculum.


Participants will have the opportunity to:
